## What to Bring List

As we go out from our church, we need to remember that the rules do not change. We always hope that there will be no problems, but if there is, we will have to discipline accordingly. These are some guidelines as to what you should and should not bring on this trip.

### What to Bring:

- ⇒ Change of clothes for 6 days
- ⇒ 4 sets of work clothes (grungy clothes; modest t-shirts and shorts, no tank tops or sleeveless shirts)
- ⇒ Sleeping Bag/Pillow (or linens)
- ⇒ Bible, pen/pencil
- ⇒ Work gloves and hat/hammer/nail apron
- ⇒ Closed toe shoes for worksite/Appropriate footwear for high adventure activities
- ⇒ Rain gear
- ⇒ Toiletries (shampoo, toothbrush, toothpaste, etc.)
- ⇒ Camera
- ⇒ Money for 3 meals (Sunday dinner; Thursday dinner at ballpark; Friday dinner) and extra money for snacks/gift shop.
- ⇒ Swimsuit (one piece)
- ⇒ Insect repellent and SUNSCREEN!
- ⇒ Water bottle (VERY IMPORTANT!!!)
- ⇒ Towel (Beach and shower)
- ⇒ Shower shoes/sandals
- ⇒ Flashlight
- ⇒ A good heart and a cheerful attitude

### What NOT to Bring:

- ⇒ Any tobacco products, drugs, and alcohol
- ⇒ A radio (if you want to listen to music, bring a discman/walkman or mp3 player)
- ⇒ Guns, knives, fireworks, firecrackers (matches or a lighter)
- ⇒ A whining attitude (The most popular)
